Entrance Fees are included as indicated in the spots to visit.

Note: If there will be oil price increase, boat rent will increase. The fuel price difference would be would just be collected on the spot per boat basis.

Contact Person will meet you in Coron in your place of lodging. Or it is also possible that you would be dropped by first to the DIY Coron Office or you could be met at the airport.

4. Transportation

Upon arrival in the airport, JayJay Van Driver 09284083105 will fetch you. You don't have to pay Jayjay for the transfer service.

If you are lodging at Princess Of Coron or Mt Tapyas Hotel, airport transfer will be provided by the lodge.

Just look for the "DIY Coron" sign or YOUR NAME. The van will take you to your intended destination. When going back to the airport, the same van driver will seek for you.

Please ignore other airport transfer offer, because this means you will have to pay for your own airport transfer.

Just in case Jayjay will not be available, Gerald 09212652210 or Danmar 09205404488 will serve as alternates.

5. Food

Lunch and snacks food is always included in the boat and calauit day trip, but not in the half day trip. When it is an island overnight, 4 meals is usually covered. Island Meal is composed of grilled seafoods (catch of the day such as fish or squid), ready-to-eat vegetables (such as cucumber, tomato, grilled eggplant, seaweeds), fruits (such as banana lacatan), water and softdrink. For 1-4pax number of joiners, only water would be provided, no softdrink.

For island overnight, sample breakfast items (when in island overnight) are fried or

plain rice, corned beef, dried fish or squid, fried egg, coffee or tea, bread, sausage.

Dinner or lunch could also be arranged in the package, but this is not the default package. Depending on the place of lodging, dinner and lunch meal rates are different. Dinner price range = 200-400/person. Lunch price range = 200-300/person.

6. General Safety & Health

Do not hold on or step on to rocks or coral when in the sea or lagoon. The rocks there are very sharp. I have seen injury from this seeming harmless stone. Do not jump from the boat or from a higher platform. To avoid touching the sea urchin, when snorkeling always lay flat. To avoid jellyfish, always look what's underneath through snorkeling. When you see a jellyfish underwater, just slowly avoid them. Do not drink beer or any liquor while on the boat or while in the tour spots.

Do not forget to bring the following: Sun block lotion, anti-mosquito lotion, shades or cap or hat, light windbreaker such sarong would do, light raincoat (during rainy season, serves as cold wind breaker), your personal medicine, etc.

First aid kit is available from the boat captain.

7. Snorkeling Gears Rental

Snorkel gears can be rented in the town. The boatman or the local guide usually have rentals at P150/day. My general advise is to bring your own snorkel gears. Rented snorkels usually is damaged or lost, and when this happens you have to pay for it.

If you think you will rarely use the snorkel but you want to buy a new one, you can sell it to me at a second hand price (less than P500).

8. Kids Rate

It should be free for below 4 years old, and half rate for entrance fee for 4-10 years old. But it do vary in some Coron spots. If this happens, the guide will notify you about it. Please just add corresponding entrance fee payment for kids.

9. Environmental Advocacy

Please bring your own re-usable drinking cup or mug. A plastic bottle can also be used in refilling your drinks, but its narrow mouth may make refilling quite difficult. In this way, the use of disposable plastic cups will be minimized. My guide would always buy disposable drinking cup. But let us try not to use that by bringing our own re-usable drinking cup/mug/bottle. This is just one way of making our environment clean.

10. Payment

Payment is to be done on the spot before the start of the tour or one day before. Give payment only to the assigned Contact Person. This will give your guide and boatman time to buy and prepare food and supplies.

For the moment, me and my local tour coordinators does not issue Official Receipts for our services. What they can do is write in a piece of paper the proof of receiving money. In the same manner, almost all spots in Coron does not issue an Official Receipt for their entrance fee. The Tagbanua Tribe does issue however their own version of receipt for the Coron Island spots entrance fee. And also the boat rental operators there does not issue Official Receipt as such. For your information only.
